Cynthia Carey-Grant is Executive Director of Women Organized to Respond to Life-Threatening Diseases (WORLD), one of the oldest, largest and most respected organizations for women living with HIV in the United States. Cynthia has also served in leadership roles in several prominent women's health organizations, including the Planned Parenthood Federation of America. She was Manager for Women's Health with The Permanente Medical Group, where she worked to advance women's health within Kaiser Permanente.

Cynthia has served as a member of the Alameda County Office of the AIDS Administration Collaborative Community Planning Council, Co-Chair of the Alameda County Prevention Committee, and member of the CCPC Executive Committee and Quality & Data Services Planning Committee. She is also a founding member of the Sankofa Collaborative, a partnership of African American and Afro-Latino health professionals dedicated to addressing the impact of HIV and AIDS on African American women and their families.
