Dr Judith Auerbach is Professor of Medicine at the Center for AIDS Prevention Studies, University of California, San Francisco, and an independent science and policy consultant. Dr Auerbach received her PhD in sociology from the University of California, Berkeley, and has taught, presented and published widely in the areas of HIV/AIDS, social science, public policy and sex and gender. Dr Auerbach has served on numerous professional and advisory groups, including the National Advisory Council on Drug Abuse, PEPFAR Scientific Advisory Board, NIH Office of AIDS Research Advisory Council, Institute of Medicine Committee on the Outcome and Impact Evaluation of PEPFAR, American Sociological Association Council, the Global HIV Prevention Working Group and the International Centre for Science in Drug Policy. In 2012, she was elected to the Governing Council of the International AIDS Society; she was re-elected in 2016. As a consultant, she advises about scientific agenda setting, strategic planning and priority setting and linking research and policy. Her clients include government agencies, non-profit and advocacy organizations and universities.
